


Welcome to Kudan!!

The purpose of this course is to provide students with many practices of daily conversation for their spoken & listening skills to be brushed up. In this course, you will also experience authentic Japanese culture, tradition, and society through the various activities provided. Thus, you can enjoy your language study as well as sightseeing in Japan. For your accommodation, we will arrange "Homestay". Living with a Japanese family makes it possible for you to experience "REAL JAPAN", and we believe your Japanese communication skills will improve dramatically.

* For over 15 years old (High school student and older)

* Please make sure to purchase travel insurance before coming to Japan.

* Accommodation: We can arrange homestay or guesthouse.

*We do not have host families that can accommodate students who have epilepsy, mental illness (including the past), or who require vegetarian or gluten-free diet so we will arrange a guesthouse.

* We stay in hotels for overnight trips. Due to the large number of participants, we divide the students into several groups, so they share the room. Groups will be divided based on the gender specified in the students' passports.

* Inclement weather and unforeseen circumstances may affect certain outdoor activities and can be changed on the day of the activity.

* No refunds will be made if activities or trips are cancelled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.

*For students whose flights are cancelled and cannot arrive as scheduled, we will arrange a taxi to meet their new arrival date and time. In this case, we charge 10,000 yen per person as airport transfer rearrangement.

This program provides you with a "HOMESTAY". Please understand and accept the following conditions below:

- (1) Please understand that every host family will vary in terms of religion, occupation, race, nationality, lifestyle, and financial situation.
- (2) We take into consideration student requests as listed on the application form and homestay questionnaire; however, it may not be possible to grant all requests. Kudan reserves the right to make any final decisions regarding student placement.
- (3) There may be a delay in sending the homestay matching report to students due to late receipt of the application, changes in arrangements, or sudden family cancellation etc.
- (4) Host family changes will not be permitted based solely on an individual's request.
- (5) It may occur that two students or more stay in one family due to an application delay, last-minute host family cancellation or change etc.
- (6) It may occur that a student is placed with several different families due to an application delay, last minute host family cancellation or change etc.
- (7) Please note that commuting will usually be one hour or more, as the school is not located in a residential area.

HOMESTAY

- (1) The lifestyle and customs (toilet, bathroom etc) of each family will vary in each household. Please follow what the other members of the family do.
- (2) Please make every effort to clearly communicate your thoughts and feelings. Kudan staff are available to assist you if required. Please also keep it mind that the Japanese way of thinking, manners may be different from your home country.
- (3) Please ask permission from your family and school before inviting your friends' home or going out. Please make sure to give priority to your host family's schedule. Please also take into consideration their schedules when making requests of them.
- (4) It is not considered acceptable to invite one's boyfriend/girlfriend into one's bedroom.
- (5) Please keep all valuables (travelers' checks, cash, watches, cameras etc) in a safe place such as a locked suitcase. Your personal items are your responsibility.
- (6) Please always carry your passport with you.
- (7) Every family will have different mealtimes. Please follow your family's schedule.
- (8) Please obey Japanese law and the school's regulations regarding smoking and drinking restrictions.
- (9) Driving (car, motorcycle, etc.) is prohibited.
- (10) Students are responsible for cleaning their own room and doing their dishes. It is greatly appreciated if students offer to assist with their family's household chores.
- (11) If a student has agreed to join a party, a trip and sightseeing which their host family has organized, they will be responsible for paying your own way.
- (12) A student will be responsible for paying for all their individual purchases, meals outside of the home, telephone costs etc.
- (13) Please attend all the activities in the program. Fees will NOT be refunded if you do not attend or participate in the planned activities.
- (14) A student's homestay will be changed to a hotel/dormitory stay if it is considered that the student is not abiding by the regulations of the program. The student will be responsible for paying any additional fees incurred for accommodation, meals, and transportation.

Changes

- (1) Please be aware that your host family may be changed in the event of a sudden accident, sickness, natural disaster etc. If this occurs prior to your departure for Japan, you may be placed temporarily in a hotel or dormitory until a new placement can be made.
- (2) In the case where a homestay has been cancelled after the student has departed for Japan, students may be placed in a hotel or dormitory until a new arrangement can be made.
- (3) In the above two cases, Kudan will pay for any additional accommodation charges and transportation fees if these fees exceed your initial payment. Please note that the cost of meals and other individual expenses will not be covered.
- (4) Students will be required to stay in a hotel for the evening if they are unable to reach their homestay due to arriving on a flight after 18:00. Students will be responsible for the cost of the hotel. Kudan reserves the right to make changes in the program schedule (excursions, trips, lessons etc.) and will inform students of these changes as soon as possible.

Application Procedures and Regulations

1. How to apply

Please fill out and sign the application form and send it back to us by email. We will send you the invoice.

2. Payment deadline

Payment needs to be made within 30 days from the invoice issue date.

3. Cancellation

Notification of intention to cancel course participation will only be accepted in writing.

Cancellation by telephone is unacceptable.

4. Cancellation charge

In the event of cancellation, applicants will be required to pay a cancellation fee.

5. Refund policy

Cancellation

Before the course starts:

- (1) Applicants may cancel their participation in the course prior to the starting date; however, they will be required to pay a cancellation fee (as detailed below). The cancellation fee will be deducted from the total amount paid. In cases where the amount received is not enough to cover the full amount of the cancellation charge, applicants will be asked to make up the difference.
- (2) A full refund will only be given under the following conditions:
 - a. When an applicant's spouse or member of their immediate family passes away.
 - b. Natural disasters, transportation strikes, and other uncontrollable events occur.
 - c. When the course cannot operate regularly or begin as regularly scheduled.

*If the applicants did not meet policy 2 (payment deadline), we will see it was cancelled.

After the course starts: No part of the program fee will be refunded.
